Dear Exporters,

We are pleased to inform you that the following irradiation facilities have been approved by Department of Agriculture, Government of Malaysia for the export of Mangoes from India to Malaysia.

- Maharashtra State Agricultural Marketing Board (MSAMB) Irradiation Treatment Center, APMC Market Yard, Sector 19 F, Vashi, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra - 400705.
- Krushak Gamma Irradiation Facility, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Khamgaon Road, Lasalgaon, Nashik, Maharashtra - 422306.
- Innova Agri Bio Park Ltd., Plot No. B-12, 3rd Phase, KIADB, Industrial Area, MALUR-563160, Kolar District (Karnataka).

It has been mentioned by Malaysian authorities that for facilitation of mango export for 2023 season, the current import requirements of mango would remain valid.

Further, it has been informed that the Malaysia's Food Irradiation Regulations 2011 also require all irradiated food imported in Malaysia to carry an irradiation certificate.

A copy of the import requirement and format for the irradiation certificate is enclosed for your reference.

Interested Exporters are requested to avail the opportunity and comply with the requirement for export mangoes to Malaysia. APEDA will be happy to organize a Special Mango Promotion activity in Malaysia in association with interested exporters very soon and expect interested exporters to give their consent.




### IMPORT REQUIREMENTS FOR IMPORTATION OF MANGO FROM INDIA INTO MALAYSIA

Status	Revised 22092020
Common Name	Mango
Scientific Name	<i>Mangifera indica</i>
Description Form	Fresh fruit
Country of Origin	India
Import Condition	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Import Licence shall be sought from the relevant Ministry in Malaysia.</li><li>2. A copy of this Import Permit (IP) shall be sent to the consignor.</li><li>3. Consignment shall be accompanied with:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Import Permit (IP) from Malaysian Authority;</li><li>b. Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) shall have the following in the additional declaration column:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. The Malaysian Import Permit (IP) reference number; and/or</li><li>ii. Quarantine treatment certificate reference number (if related).</li></ol></li></ol></li><li>4. Treatment shall be done prior to export and consignment must be exported within fourteen (14) days from the date of PC issued.</li><li>5. Consignment shall be inspected and certified free from soil, pests, diseases, weed seeds contaminants and regulated articles by National Plant Protection Organization (NPPO) of exporting country.</li><li>6. Consignment is allowed to enter at KLIA International Airport and Port Klang only.</li><li>7. Consignment is subjected to visual inspection, examination or analysis prior to clearance by Malaysian Quarantine &amp; Inspection Service (MAQIS) officer upon arrival at the point of entry into Malaysia.</li><li>8. MAQIS officer(s) will take sample base on symptoms/signs of infestation on the consignment at the point of entry. The sample will be sent to the Biosecurity Screening Unit at Serdang, Selangor, Malaysia for screening of pests, diseases and regulated articles.</li><li>9. If any pests, diseases and other regulated articles are present during the post-entry quarantine screening process, Department of Agriculture (DOA) Malaysia have the right to suspend future importation, until the cause of the non-compliance is investigated, identified and rectified to the satisfaction of DOA Malaysia.</li><li>10. All cost incurred during screening activities will be borne by the importer.</li></ol>

The following consignment must be accompanied with report of the minimum and maximum dosage.</li> <li>3. Each box containing the irradiated mango must be labeled.</li> <li>4. The consignment must be accompanied with registration certificate of irradiation premises issued by the Authority in India.</li> </ol>
