Grain and Feed Update

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Report Highlights:

The Government of Pakistan (GOP) granted approval for the export of an additional 500,000 tons of wheat with a subsidy of \$105 per ton. Consequently, Pakistan's MY 2018/19 wheat export forecast is revised upward to 1.7 MMT. Pakistan's MY 2018/19 wheat production is adjusted downwards to 25.1 MMT, in accordance with the latest GOP data. Based on preliminary official data, Pakistan has exported 4.0 MMT of rice during MY17/18 as compared to 3.6 MMT during the preceding marketing year.

Pakistan Approves Additional 50,000 Tons Subsidized Wheat Exports

The Government of Pakistan (GOP) granted approval for the export of additional 500,000 tons of wheat with a subsidy of \$105 per ton. In early 2018 the GOP announced a \$159 per metric ton subsidy on wheat exports which technically expired on June 30, 2018, but the subsidized wheat for which approval was taken before the subject date continued to be shipped in the subsequent months. Consequently Pakistan's MY 2018/19 wheat export forecast is revised upward to 1.7 MMT. Pakistan's MY 2018/19 wheat production is adjusted downwards to 25.1 MMT, in accordance with the latest GOP data.

Pakistan has so far exported about 800,000 tons of subsidized wheat during current marketing year excluding Afghanistan. The wheat is mainly going to Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Gulf and some African countries. Exports to Afghanistan have been declining over the years mainly due to stricter border control measures. Pakistan is forecast to export between 300,000 to 400,000 tons of wheat to Afghanistan during the current marketing year.

Production, Supply and Demand Data Statistics:

Rice:

Based on preliminary official data, Pakistan has exported 4.0 MMT of rice during MY17/18 as compared to 3.6 MMT during the preceding marketing year (Table 1). FAS Islamabad amended the PSD accordingly. Rice production forecast for MY 2018/19 is unchanged at 7.4 MMT. Continuing devaluation of the Pakistani rupee against the dollar (around 25 percent during 2018) is making Pakistani rice more competitive. Pakistan is also benefiting from the Tricyclazole issue effecting the exports of Indian rice. Tricyclazole is generally not used in Pakistan. Pakistan rice exports have been strong this year and the Rice Exporters Association of Pakistan (REAP) expects this trend to continue. Pakistan is also trying to increase its share in the high valued Basmati market and this will likely result in a shift towards more basmati exports.
