Export of Organic Products under Private Labelling

Dear Certification Bodies,

It has been brought to the notice of APEDA that the National Regulation of few countries cover the requirement of private labeling for trade of organic products. As such provisions do not exist in National Programme for Organic Products (NPOP), the following have been included in the NPOP.

Accordingly, Chapter 3 Appendix 5 clause 6:6.1 (iv) of NPOP has been amended as follows:

The name and address of the person or company legally responsible for the production or processing of the product shall be mentioned on the label. If private labeling requirements are covered in the National Regulation of the importing country, the accredited Certification Body shall approve the labels following such requirements for export to respective country ensuring that traceability of the product can be established at any stage of handing. However, the export of private labelled products undertaken through recognition agreement with the importing country shall follow the validity and scope of agreement.

The Certification Bodies may comply with the above based on the requirements of the National Regulation of the importing country as well.

This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
